We hereby invite abstracts for papers in phenomenology and related areas of philosophy. We welcome suggestions for individual papers as well as joint panels on current topics or recently published books. Proposals, which will be evaluated by the board of the society through a blind-review process, are invited from senior researchers as well as from graduate students.

This year we also announce in advance six specified panels that will be organized as part of the meeting. If you would like to participate in one of these particular panels with your paper, please state the title of the panel in question after the title of your abstract. The panels (and their directors) are:

- *Phenomenology and Deconstruction: On the Legacy of Derrida* (Hans Ruin)
- *Phenomenology and Post-colonial Thought* (Cecilia Sjöholm & Nicholas Smith)
- *Phenomenology and Literature* (Marcia Sá Cavalcante Schuback & Sven-Olov Wallenstein)
- *Phenomenological readings in the history of philosophy* (Charlotta Weigelt)
- *Phenomenology and medicine* (Fredrik Svenaeus)
- *Phenomenology of religious experience* (Jonna Bornemark & Jayne Svenungsson)

The proposals should be prepared for blind review and composed in the following manner:

**A) Proposals for individual papers** should consist of two separate documents containing the following: 1) The title and the abstract (maximum 300 words) of your presentation. The abstract should include: topic/field, new contribution, general outline. 2) A separate cover letter including the following information: title of presentation; name, affiliation and contact information.

**B) Proposals for joint panels in addition to the ones mentioned above** (one individual sends the proposal on behalf of all the participants) should consist of two separate documents containing the following: 1) The title and a short description of the topic of the panel; and an abstract from each of the participants (maximum 300 words each); 2) A separate cover letter including the following information: the title of the panel; names and affiliations of all the participants; contact information of the individual in charge of the panel.
